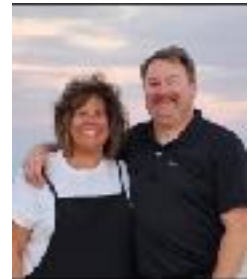

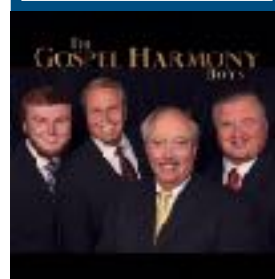
Don Beougher

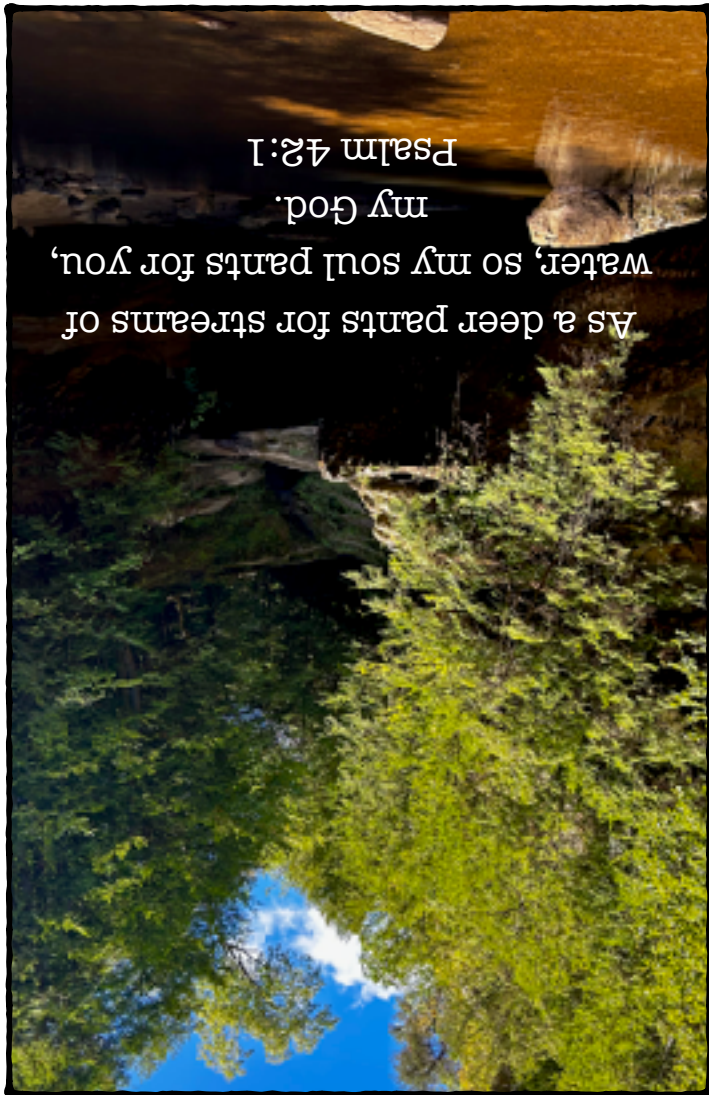
